4.	Aspects of Course Covered by Examination: Hypothesis-driven project
5.	Form of Examination:
5.1	BVetMed or BVSc Years 1, 2 and 3 examinations previously taken, obtaining at least 40% in the third year written assessments. Excluding the portfolio, the written elements of the third year accrue 90 CP.
5.2	Project Report (RP2) from Final Year BVetMed or BVSc* OR Hypothesis Driven 30 CP Research Project of between 3000 - 4000 words and 15-minute oral presentation. <i>*Applies to projects completed during Final Year in 2012 or later.</i>
6.	Requirement to be Completed to Permit Entry to the Examination The student must have formally relinquished their registration for the award of BVetMed or BVSc and have met the entry requirements of the course regulations.
